



Scholarship and Discount FAQs

Where does the scholarship money come from?

Scholarships are made possible through the direct donations of generous individuals and organizations. Scholarship money is not raised from the fees we charge our campers. If you would like to donate to our scholarship program, or if you have any questions about donating, check out our donation page at graceadventures.org.

Who is eligible to receive a scholarship?

All prospective campers with financial needs are eligible to apply. The maximum amount that Grace Adventures provides for any individual registering for Main Camp is 50% of the camper fee. The maximum amount for any individual registering for Paradise Ranch is 30% of the camper fee. Last year, almost 150 campers received a scholarship.

Am I guaranteed a scholarship?

It is our desire that no child miss out on a Grace Adventures camping experience because of financial circumstances. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee every request will be granted.

Does my application register my child for camp?

No. You can register online at graceadventures.org or fax/mail the registration form and deposit per camper along with this application. However, if for any reason you are denied a scholarship and unable to attend, this deposit will be refunded to you in full.

What kind of deposit will be required?

A deposit of \$100 per camper is required when registering.

How will I find out if I received a scholarship?

Grace Adventures will notify recipients by phone or email.

Does the scholarship cover all costs for the camper?

No. Scholarships are given based on individual needs. The parent or guardian is responsible to pay any portion of the camper fee not covered by the scholarship as well as any additional optional activity fees (horse ride, dune ride, etc) and spending money for the camp store.

What if I receive a scholarship and then cannot come to camp?

Please notify the Registrar at 231-873-3662. As per our cancellation policy, your registration deposit of \$100 will not be refunded but any other camp fees you have paid on your camper's account will be refunded to you.

Why do I need to ask my church if they are able to help my camper?

Many churches are willing to provide assistance for campers from their church to attend summer camp. If you regularly attend a church, we require that you check to see if they are able to contribute a part of your camper's balance. A representative from your church must fill out and sign the appropriate section on your application. If you do not attend a church, write "not applicable" in this space. We are unable to process applications that do not have this section filled out.

If I am receiving a scholarship for my camper, do other discounts also apply?

If your camper is granted a scholarship through Grace Adventures, the following discounts will not be applied to your camper's account: Early Registration, Sibling, Multi-Week. The Bring-A-Friend Discount will still be applied.

I don't need a scholarship, but are there other options that can help out with reducing my camper's fee?

We understand the economy is uncertain. We want to come alongside your family to help your kids experience camp this summer through discounts offered and/or a payment plan tailored to your need.
