Important Weekend Information

Check-In is at 4:00PM on Friday at Paradise Ranch.

- o Your housing assignment will be given when you at Check-In. One of our staff will direct you to your housing location.
- o If you require a Late Check-In, please call our office during business hours, if possible, so we can offer assistance with Check-In when you arrive.
- o Following Check-In you will be given a weekend outline, barn orientation, and other helpful weekend information by our staff.
- o Please do not arrive before 4:00PM on Friday as we may be serving other groups at that time.

The weekend will wrap up on Sunday at 1:00 PM after a Trail Ride.

If you have any special needs or dietary needs, please let us know about those at least 2 weeks ahead of time on your online health form.

The Mercantile is climate controlled, so it will be a comfortable space all weekend long.

Grace Adventures Paradise Ranch is a drug, marijuana, and alcohol free campus.

Housing

Everyone will be housed in the bunkhouses at Paradise Ranch during the weekend

Housing is assigned by Grace Adventures Staff

Attendees must bring their own bedding, including pillow, sheets, and/or sleeping bag

All housing and buildings are smoke-free

Housing units are three-season Cabins – please bring weather appropriate bedding

Bunkhouses and the main bathhouse are not heated or air-conditioned

Attendees may choose to stay in their horse trailers for the weekend but there is no electricity hook-up available for horse trailers.

Housing is subject to change in case of cold weather or available space. Additional housing is on Grace Adventures' Main Campus.

Helpful Information

Bring Your Horse!

We encourage you to bring your own horse, after all, this is a Ranch Retreat!

We provide temporary uncovered outdoor stalls to board horses in during the weekend. Stalls are made up of livestock panels. All accommodations are available on a first-come first-serve basis.

If you do not have your own horse, no problem! A horse can be provided for you from our Paradise Ranch herd.

Women's Ranch Retreat Online Registration

The Women's Ranch Retreat registration is done completely online. With your registration, we will require a completed health and liability waiver form. This helps make us aware of any medical needs and allows anytime access to you and our staff without the hassle of paper forms.

Directions

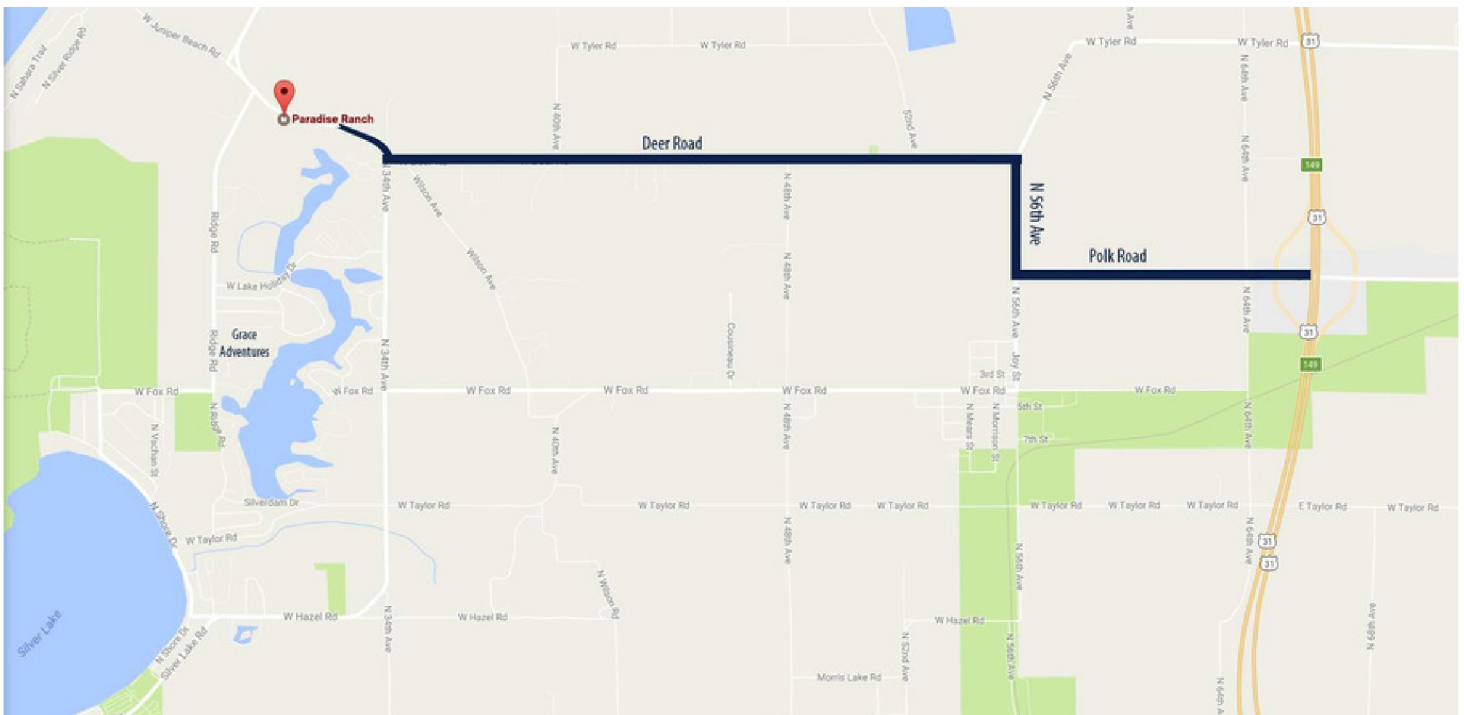
Paradise Ranch is located about 35 miles **North of Muskegon**, 20 miles **South of Ludington**, and 80 miles **Northwest of Grand Rapids**. Grace Adventures is on Upper Silver Lake, almost 7 miles West of US-31. The closest commercial airports are Grand Rapids and Muskegon.

Traveling from **Muskegon**, follow **US-31 Northbound** to **Hart/Mears** (Exit 149). Turn **Left** (West) and stay on this road until it stops (approx 1 ½ mile) and follow the Grace Adventures signs.

Traveling from **Ludington**, follow **US-31 Southbound** to **Hart/Mears** (Exit 149). Turn **Right** (West) and stay on this road until it stops (approx 1 ½ mile) and follow the Grace Adventures signs.

Traveling from **Grand Rapids**, follow **I-96 West** to **Muskegon**, then follow the above directions from Muskegon.

What to Bring

- ☐ Appropriate clothing to ride in
- ☐ Jacket or Sweatshirt
- ☐ Rain Gear
- ☐ Warm bedding and your pillow
- ☐ Personal Hygiene Items (Including towel and washcloth)
- ☐ Closed-Toe, Closed-Heel Shoes (riding boots are preferred but not required)
- ☐ Comfortable clothes and shoes for when not riding
- ☐ Lawn/camping chair or stadium chair
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Flashlight

If You Are Bringing Your Own Horse

- ☐ Riding equipment (saddle, bridle, halter, etc.)
- ☐ Feeding and other necessary equipment (ex. Hay, water bucket, etc.)

Please Do Not Bring

- ☐ Alcohol, Tobacco, Marijuana, Firearms, or Weapons
- ☐ Non-Prescription or Illegal Drugs
- ☐ Fireworks or Prank Items
- ☐ Pets

Note: Any necessary medication should be kept in a safe and secure place where others can't access it

We recommend that you “unplug” during this retreat. Cell phones and other electronics can be a distraction. Anything brought on campus, including electronics, is the owner's responsibility. We are not responsible for items lost, stolen, or broken.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the Registration Fee Include?

In short, everything! The registration fee is all-inclusive. All housing, meals, and activities are included. The only extra money you may need is for extra snacks, drinks, and apparel at our Camp Store during the weekend.

Is Wi-Fi available during the retreat?

Because of the beautiful and remote area that surrounds us, we do not offer Wi-Fi to our guests during their stay. We encourage you to disconnect from the internet and enjoy time outdoors.

What if any of us have special dietary needs?

We are happy to accommodate some dietary needs and restrictions that our guests may have. We are pleased to offer gluten free, dairy free, peanut/tree nut free and vegetarian options. If your allergy/dietary restrictions fall into any of these four categories please inform us at least one week prior to your experience by filling out those needs on your online health form.

How many people usually come to the Women's Ranch Retreat?

Every year is different and will have a variable number of people, typically weekends will be between 20-35 people.

What should we do in case of emergencies?

In the event of an emergency, please call 911 and inform a Grace Adventures staff member. Make sure you have the proper insurance and medical information on hand. At the beginning of the event you'll be given more information on how to reach a staff member at any time. The nearest hospital is Mercy Health Lakeshore in Shelby, MI.
